



## Communion Invitation


**Dear Guest:** If you are not a member of the Lutheran Church- Missouri Synod, please speak to pastor before taking the Lord's Supper.

Silence for reflection on God's Word and for self-examination.

But I am heartily sorry for them and sincerely repent of them, and I pray You of Your boundless mercy and for the sake of the holy, innocent, bitter sufferings and death of Your beloved Son, Jesus Christ, to be gracious and merciful to me, a poor, sinful being.

- P Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office, as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the T Son and of the Holy Spirit.







# 1 Kings 17:17-24

You have come to me to bring my iniquity to remembrance and to put my son to death!" <sup>19</sup> He said to her, "Give me your son." 
# Ephesians 3:13–21

<sup>13</sup> Therefore I ask you not to lose heart at my tribulations on your behalf, for they are your glory. <sup>14</sup>For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, <sup>15</sup>from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, <sup>16</sup>that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man, <sup>17</sup>so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love, <sup>18</sup>may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, <sup>19</sup>and to know the love of Christ which surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled up to all the fullness of God.




# The Words of Our Lord
