

#### **Communion Invitation**


**Dear Guest:** If you are not a member of the Lutheran Church- Missouri Synod, please speak to pastor before taking the Lord's Supper.

#### Old Testament Reading (NASB95)

Deuteronomy 10:12–21

<sup>12</sup>"Now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require from you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways and love Him, and to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul<sup>13</sup> and to keep the LORD'S commandments and His statutes which I am commanding you today for your good? <sup>14</sup>"Behold, to the LORD your God belong heaven and the highest heavens, the earth and all that is in it. <sup>15</sup> "Yet on your fathers did the LORD set His affection to love them, and He chose their descendants after them, even you above all peoples, as it is this day. <sup>16</sup> "So circumcise your heart, and stiffen your neck no longer.<sup>17</sup> "For the LORD your God is the God of gods and the Lord of lords, the great, the mighty, and the awesome God who does not show partiality nor take a bribe.<sup>18</sup> "He executes justice for the orphan and the widow, and shows His love for the alien by giving him food and clothing.<sup>19</sup> "So show your love for the alien, for you were aliens in the land of Egypt. <sup>20</sup> "You shall fear the LORD your God; you shall serve Him and cling to Him, and you shall swear by His name.

<sup>21</sup> "He is your praise and He is your God, who has done these great and awesome things for you which your eyes have seen.

<sup>1</sup> After the uproar had ceased, Paul sent for the disciples, and when he had exhorted them and taken his leave of them, he left to go to Macedonia. <sup>2</sup> When he had gone through those districts and had given them much exhortation, he came to Greece. 3 And there he spent three months, and when a plot was formed against him by the Jews as he was about to set sail for Syria, he decided to return through Macedonia. <sup>4</sup> And he was accompanied by Sopater of Berea, the son of Pyrrhus, and by Aristarchus and Secundus of the Thessalonians, and Gaius of Derbe, and Timothy, and Tychicus and Trophimus of Asia. <sup>5</sup> But these had gone on ahead and were waiting for us at Troas. <sup>6</sup> We sailed from Philippi after the days of Unleavened Bread, and came to them at Troas within five days; and there we stayed seven days. On the first day of the week, when we were gathered together to break bread, Paul began talking to them, intending to leave the next day, and he prolonged his message until midnight. 8 There were many lamps in the upper room where we were gathered together. 9 And there was a young man named Eutychus sitting on the window sill, sinking into a deep sleep; and as Paul kept on talking, he was overcome by sleep and fell down from the third floor and was picked up dead. <sup>10</sup>But Paul went down and fell upon him, and after embracing him, he said, "Do not be troubled, for his life is in him." 11 When he had gone back up and had broken the bread and eaten, he talked with them a long while until daybreak, and then left.

#### Holy Gospel (NASB95)

Matthew 22:34–46

- P The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew the twenty-second chapter.
- C Glory to You, O Lord.

<sup>34</sup>But when the Pharisees heard that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered themselves together.<sup>35</sup> One of them, a lawyer, asked Him a question, testing Him, <sup>36</sup>Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" <sup>37</sup> And He said to him, "'YOU SHALL LOVE THE LORD YOUR GOD WITH ALL YOUR HEART, AND WITH ALL YOUR SOUL, AND WITH ALL YOUR MIND.<sup>38</sup> "This is the great and foremost commandment.<sup>39</sup> "The second is like it, 'YOU SHALL LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR AS YOURSELF.' <sup>40</sup> "On these two commandments depend the whole Law and the Prophets." <sup>41</sup> Now while the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them a question: <sup>42</sup> "What do you think about the Christ, whose son is He?" They \*said to Him, "The son of David." <sup>43</sup> He said to them, "Then how does David in the Spirit call Him 'Lord,' saying <sup>44</sup> 'THE LORD SAID TO MY LORD, "SIT AT MY RIGHT HAND, UNTIL I PUT YOUR ENEMIES BENEATH YOUR FEET" '? <sup>45</sup> "If David then calls Him 'Lord,' how is He his son?" <sup>46</sup> No one was able to answer Him a word, nor did anyone dare from that day on to ask Him another question.

C I believe in God, the Father Almighty,







forever and ever. Amen.


#### The Words of Our Lord
