Invocation


- P In the name of the Father and of the T Son and of the Holy Spirit.

- C Amen.







Responsive Reading


John 1:1–14

- P In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- C He was in the beginning with God.
- P All things were made through Him, and without Him was not any thing made that was made.
- C In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men.
- P The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.
- C There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.
- P He came as a witness, to bear witness about the Light, that all might believe through him.
- C He was not the light, but came to bear witness about the light.
- P The true Light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world.

C He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, yet the world did not know Him.

- P He came to his own, and his own people did not receive Him.
- C But to all who did receive Him, who believed in His name,
